

## 2023 BUS SERVICE IMPROVEMENTS

Norfolk County Council consistently assesses contracted bus services to optimise the effective utilisation of public funds. The following enhancements, implemented in 2023, have significantly impacted local communities. Importantly, all these improvements have been implemented without incurring any additional costs for taxpayers, as many of them are integral components of broader reviews.

### Sanders

- Service 22,22A: A new Thursday only service into Fakenham from the Litcham and West Raynham area.
- Service 23: Expanded service to provide a Wednesday only journey into Norwich for Lyng and Elsing.
- Service 26,27,28: Expanded service providing a journey from the Creakes to Burnham Market taking in the housing estates of South Burnham Market, and linking the village to Fakenham.
- Service 42: A new commuter and shopping link for Foulsham into Norwich..
- Service 98A: A new Thursday only service into Fakenham from the Snorings and Kettlestone

### Our Hire

- Service 72A: New pre book service for Clippesby and Thurne into Acle
- Service 86: Improved service for Arminghall. Saturday service introduced for Alington and Bergh Apton
- Service 806, 806A: Enhanced timetabled journeys into Wymondham from the Barnham Broom area, and a new link from Wymondham, Hethersett and Little Melton to Longwater retail park
- Service 805, 805A: Friday only service expanded to include Deopham, Morley, East Carleton, Wreningham village, Penny's green into Wymondham
- Service 808A: New Tuesday and Thursday service to Longwater for Weston Longville, Ringland, Taverham and Costessey West End.

### Coach Services

- 37E,37T,37D: A new timetabled service, replacing pre book transport, serving the East Harling area providing journeys to Diss, Attleborough and Thetford.

### Konect

- Service 84: Service extended to provide shopping journeys between the Hempnall area and Long Stratton, and also Wacton and Long Stratton.
- Service 18: Tuesday and Friday only service added for North Tuddenham, Lyng, Elsing and Billingford to Dereham.
